Wait until all chance of frost is passed, even if this is not exactly late May. » Most outdoor crops will also grow happily indoors in good light. » Quick crops can be sown successively throughout the season. These include radish, rocket, snow pea, sugar snap pea, mizuna, corn salad, spinach, cress, some lettuces and some beans (especially bush beans).
